Fundraising Initiative and achievement: One of the biggest achievements we have ever attained since our AGM held in 2013 is to be able to raise a total of \$15,808.00 Canadians. There are 50 contributors till the date. We are thankful to everyone contributing to this fund. Our Big Thanks should go to Dr. Hem Raj Regmi whose super huge donation has ensured our fundraising goal. It is Emergency fund and it will go in a support of families and individuals who are severely affected by disaster in Nepal. In addition, we will use the surplus of that income to educate the children in Nepal which we have already started. To support them easily, we have deposited Nepalese 1,200,000/-in fixed account in Nepal. Support will go from the interest we

earn from our capital. \$3,500/- Canadian has been used by our board member in 5% of interest. And rest is in the bank account. Detail will be in financial report.

Volleyball activities: The birth of Baglung Sewa Samaj Canada is deeply associated with our passion to sport activities in which volleyball comes at first. Our infallible passion with volleyball brought all of us together as a result we have come to be organized under this name. Since its inception we have been actively participating in all volleyball tournaments organized by different organizations like NRN- Canada, Laligurans Sports and cultural club and Concern Nepal.

Volunteering at Himalayan MELA with NCCS in 2013

It gave us an incredible opportunity to show up publicly as an organization with uniqueness. Our coordination to recruit and deploy the volunteers was truly laudable. Volunteer participants were not from the organization itself, we became

able to recruit some from outside the organization. Thanks All the Volunteers who worked to bring

that mega event a grand success. Besides this, on behalf of organization we have been participating as volunteers to support logistics with NRN-Canada in its National Convention.

Scholarship project: In 2014, meeting of executive committee decided to commence an educational project in Nepal giving high priority in Baglung. That meeting mandated Bhabi Neupane to draft a project detail. As outlined in the project, we have already selected students from underprivileged family and awarded scholarships. As a result, we have been able to develop and start a project in Baglung and Gulmi districts in Nepal. Consequently, now 4 students have

been receiving 5,000/- Nepalese rupees every year until the rewarded student pass out SLC. For detail see the project manual.

The students receiving scholarship are: Seema Nepali, Class 7, from Kharuwa Ma Vi, Hatita-7, Karna Bdr. Khatri, Class-8, Nepal Ma Vi, Tara, Dipak Pun, Class-4, Janata Ma Vi, Rajkut and Dila Ram Chalise, Class-7, Sarada Vidya Mandir Ma Vi, Wami Maidan Gulmi.

For us to oversee this program being located in Canada is not practical. To operate this program from the beginning we have local activists in close contact so that they could act according to our vision, guideline and the instructions as outlined in the program manual. We nominated four persons as our local ambassadors to monitor and execute this program. For now, each ambassador is closely in relation with these students whom we have sponsored for their education. Mr. Toya Nath Sharma from Chamuwa Lower Secondary School, Mr. Bhim Nath Subedi from Nepal Ma Vi, Tara, Mr. Kul Bahadur K.C from Adarsa Vidya Mandir Ma Vi and Miss Sharmila Kunwar from Rajkut are serving as our ambassadors. I as a program coordinator and Chairman Durga Adhikari are in frequent communication.

We have an approximate calculation that if we are able to manage \$248.00 as per current exchange rate per year, we can smoothly run this project. If we become able to double our strength, we can provide additional 4 scholarships and educate more children and contribute to empower them. Empowering these children means to enable our community back home. The given table illustrates that the total cost to educate already awarded scholarships is estimated as given. Ultimately, this will create lots of opportunities for them.

MRP form fill up clinic: We always have a challenge to raise fund. Our members are the main financial resource. Without your support we could not reach people here and back home. To ease the act of asking financial support, we decided to do a noble work. So we commenced it viewing that it doesn't serve the need of people but also help us to outsource ourselves. As a result, we have been able to fill up more than **65** computerized MRP forms till the date from Toronto to Vancouver. One the one hand we have come to collect fund and on the other hand we

have reached with people with cause. Our collection of fees and revenue generated from it will be outlined in the financial report.

Effort to initiate fund raising: Likewise, we ran a bar at one of the musical nights organized by Hami Nepali in last April.
