We have been trying our best to contribute and distribute the relief amount in Nepal to fight against Natural calamity and life threatening diseases. We sent as a relief \$4200 in 2015 for massive earthquake, \$1229 in 2016 to wildfire victim in Dhullubaskot, Baglung, \$ 1167 to Dilu Gauchan in Brampton for her treatment of Cancer, \$500 for the land sliding victim in Resh Baglung, victim of Seti flooding Pokhara, we supported \$2000 for Dhurmush Suntali foundation to support victim of flooding in Terai region in August 2017 likewise, we decided and are going to provide NRS one lakhs to the victim of landslide in Bihu, Baglung within August first week 2018.
